Nations Veteran Cup - Propositions 2016

1. Participating nations:

Denmark A Denmark B Norway Finland Holland Wales Scotland

Each team consists of two triplets, (triplet 1 and triplet 2) (3 or 4 players per triplet) Nations, which have signed two triplets, play on the same team.

2. All triplets play 10 matches in total.

Matches are time limited to 50 minutes. When time is up, the ongoing round is played until all boules are thrown.

The triplet has one throw of the jack, and if the throw is not valid, the opponent places the jack in a position of their choice – within the rules for throwing a jack.

Match Points:

Lost match 0 point
Tied match 1 point
Won match (not achieved 13 points) 2 points
Won match (achieved 13 points) 3 points

3. The playing order for the first round is found by draw.

In the first round, all teams play against each other.

Triplet 1 meet triplet 1 and triplet 2 meet triplet 2. All 7 matches are played on Saturday.

4. After the first round, the teams are ranked by their achieved points.

Equalities are handled by these rules:

- 1. Match Points achieved in mutual match
- 2. Score differences in mutual match
- 3. Own score in mutual match
- 4. Pointing from 8 meter.

(Each team selects 3 players, who points one boule each.

Each team points alternating 3 boules. Each boule is measured and removed from the terrain, before the next boule is pointed. The team with the lowest total distance is the winner. In case of equal distances, a <u>new</u> player from each team is pointing one boule and the boule is measured and removed. The team with the shortest distance is the winner. The last part is repeated until a winner is found.)

5. After round 1 the teams are split into 2 pools

Teams ranked 1 - 4 plays in pool A Teams ranked 5 - 8 plays in pool B

Points won in the first round are carried into the second round.

6. In the second round triplet 1 meet triplet 2 from the opponent team - and vice versa.

All teams in the pool play against each other. 3 matches for each team; all played on Sunday.

Teams are ranked by their results and in case of equalities; the rule in #4 applies.
